GRADING

RANK IN CLASS

All credit classes are included in computing grade point average and class rank. Honors and Dual Enrollment courses are weighted by 1.25 and AP courses are weighted by 1.5. Only final grades are recorded on the transcript. Grade point average is computed every semester; class rank is computed once a year.

STANDARDIZED TESTS

On the most recent IOWA administration (April 2023), Veritas Christian Academy students ranked from the 60th to the 90th percentile overall on a national scale of all students who took the test at that time.

Our average SAT Reasoning Test scores for the college bound students are 620 (Critical Reading), 598 (Math) By comparison, the nationwide averages for all students in the class of 2022 were 529 (Critical Reading), 521 (Math).
